As we have children who have severe allergies I would ask all parents, grandparents and guardians to be very aware of food being sent into school for break or lunch time.

This may mean reading the labels on food bars or snacks to see if the product contains nuts or pineapple. As a further precaution we would also ask you not to send birthday cakes or homebaked goods into school. You are welcome to send alternative items such as mini-haribo sweets for birthday occasions. I have asked staff to be alert to these items coming into school and other measures have been put in place to ensure that we in school do all we can to provide a safe environment for our pupils. Your help and understanding in this matter would be very much appreciated.
