<u>Closures</u>

School will be closed on Monday 28th for the bank holiday and Tuesday 29th May for a staff development day. Term finishes for the summer holidays on Friday 29th June at 12:15 for all pupils. There will be no dinners available on the 29th June and it will be a non-uniform day. School commences again on Monday 3rd September.

Sports Day

Our schools Sports Day will be held on Friday 1st June on the grass area. Sports for Year 1 - Year 3 will be held 9.15am - 10.30am, and Year 4 - Year 7 will be held 11am - 12.00. Parents who wish to take children directly home after the sports may do so, but please inform the class teacher in writing or via the class dojo app by 19th May. On Sports Day school dinners will be available as packed lunches only. They must be ordered by week ending 18thMay. If it is wet, a decision on whether or not to hold Sports Day will be made as early as possible and parents will be informed by text message, dojo and via the school website.
